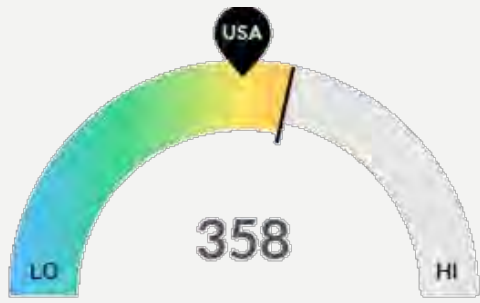
- Located at the new SCOE Building at 1325 HSt.

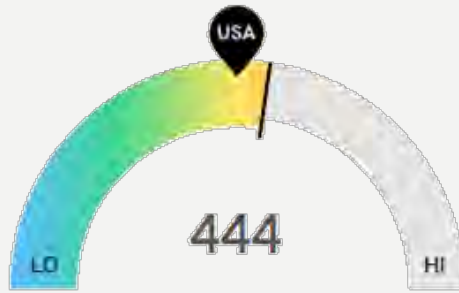

Competition from online job postings is high in your area. The national average for an area this size is 295* job postings/mo, while there are 358 here.



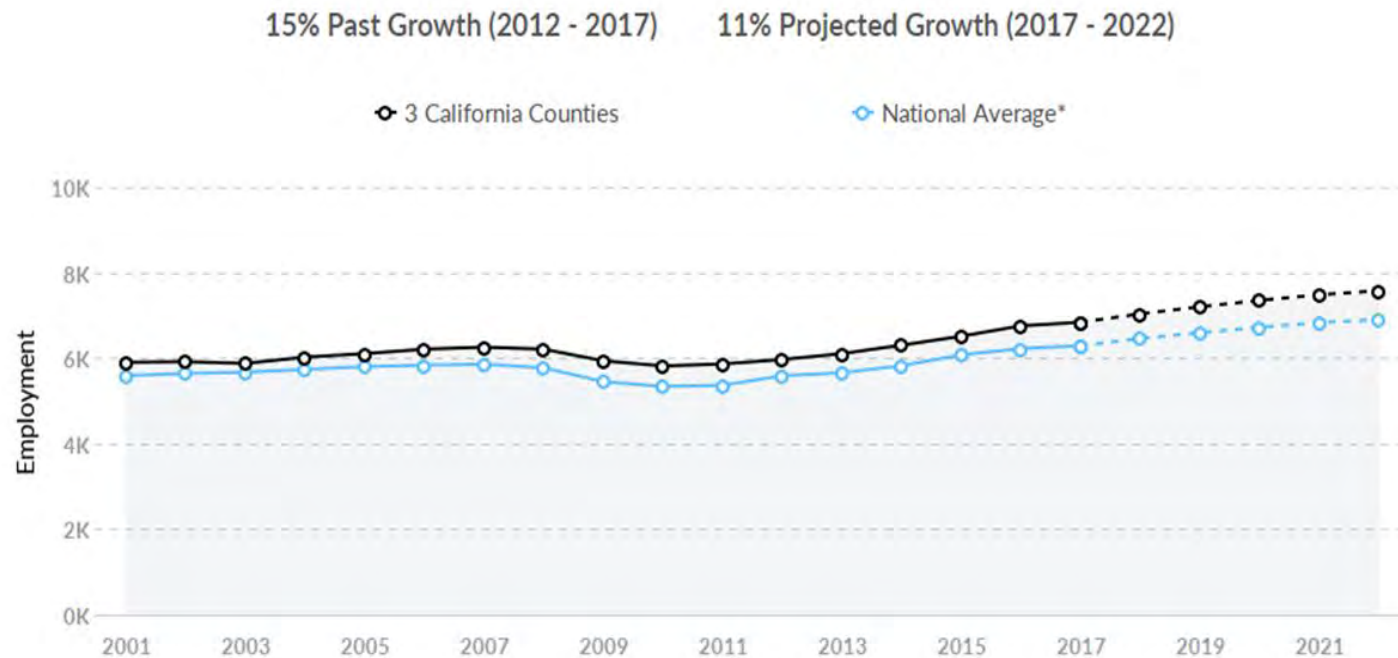
Retiring Soon

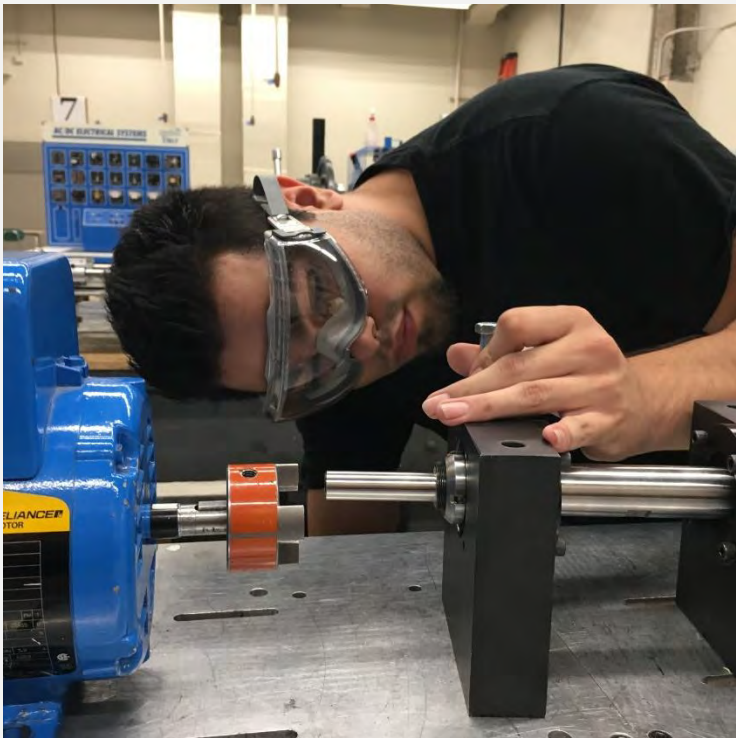
